Sir/Madam,

I have been authorized by My Client Mr. Dharamraj Mewada Add:- Indore M.P. to send a Legal Notice. As per the information and instructions provided by My Client, I, hereby sending this Legal notice to Respondent stating that:-

1. That, my client is a professional engaged in the business of software development, including website designing and development services, and has been rendering such services to various clients in the ordinary course of business.
2. That you, being the authorized representative of Ayraj Company, had approached my client with a request for development of a website and had, during initial discussions, shared a demo/reference website with a clear instruction that a similar website was required to be developed as per your business needs.
3. That, upon mutual discussions and negotiations, it was **orally agreed** between you and my client that the total consideration for the said work shall be **Rs. 18,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Thousand Only)**. It is pertinent to mention that although no written agreement was executed, the said **oral contract is legally valid and binding** under the provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872.
4. That, relying upon your representations, assurances and instructions, my client commenced the work in good faith and invested his valuable time, skill, technical expertise and resources in developing the said website strictly as per your requirements.

That, during the course of development, you initially provided details of only **8 products**, which were duly incorporated by my client in the website. However, in order to improve the quality, presentation and commercial viability of the website, my client, on his own initiative and in your interest, enhanced the website by listing approximately 40 products, thereby delivering work far exceeding the originally discussed scope.

6. That, my client ensured that all elements of the website including design, layout, product listing, structure and functionality were completed strictly in accordance with your instructions and the demo/reference shared by you, leaving no deficiency in service whatsoever.

7. That, after successful completion of the entire work and readiness of the website for delivery/use, my client approached you for release of the agreed payment of Rs. 18,000/-. However, to the utter shock and dismay of my client, you have arbitrarily and malafidely refused to accept the website and have wrongfully denied making the payment on the pretext that you no longer require the website and you misbehaved with my client.

8. That, it is submitted that once the work was duly completed as per your instructions, you are legally bound to honor your commitment and make the payment. Your refusal at this stage is illegal, unjustified and amounts to breach of contract.

9. That, your aforesaid conduct further amounts to cheating and dishonest intention from the very beginning, attracting provisions of Indian Penal Code, as you induced my client to perform services without any intention of making payment.

10. That, your actions have caused financial loss, mental harassment and wastage of professional time and resources of my client, for which you are also liable to compensate him suitably.


11. That my client is still willing to resolve the matter amicably, however, your continued refusal to pay the legitimate dues leaves my client with no option but to take appropriate legal action
